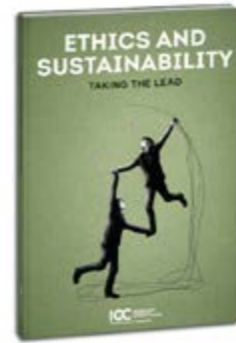

BIOGRAPHIES SPEAKERS

Mr. Henk Broeders

Chair, ICC Netherlands

Henk Broeders has been the Chairman of ICC Netherlands since 2011. From 2008 until 2012 he was Chairman of the Board of Cappingemini The Netherlands and Member of the Group Executive Committee of Cappingemini S.A., after a career in computer technology, which started at Dow Chemicals. Mr. Broeders holds a number of Supervisory Board positions including Chairman of the Supervisory Board at Mazars Accountants and Chairman of the Economic Board of the City of Utrecht.

Mr. Ludger Schuknecht

Deputy Secretary General, Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD)

Ludger Schuknecht has been OECD Deputy Secretary General since 2018. Previously, Mr. Schuknecht worked at the German Federal Ministry of Finance as an advisor to the Minister. He was also responsible for coordinating the finance track of the G20 process and worked closely alongside the OECD on a variety of programs. Mr. Schuknecht holds a PhD from the University of Konstanz, where he researched fiscal policies and its links to the financial sector and the international economy.

Mr. Richard Bistrong

CEO, Front-Line Anti-Bribery LLC

Richard Bistrong is CEO of Front-Line Anti-Bribery LLC and spent much of his career as an international sales executive. He currently consults and speaks on foreign bribery, ethics and compliance issues from his front-line perspective. In 2018, Mr. Bistrong was named by Thomson Reuters as one of the top 50 social influencers in risk and compliance. He is also a contributing editor of the FCPA Blog.

Prof. Alex Brenninkmeijer

Member of the European Court of Auditors

Prof. Alex Brenninkmeijer is the author of the book 'Moreel Leiderschap' (Moral Leadership, 2019) and has served as National Ombudsman of the Netherlands from 2005 to 2013. Mr. Brenninkmeijer is Honorary Professor of The Rule of Law's Institutional Aspects at the Faculty of Law, Economics and Governance at the University of Utrecht. He serves as Member of the European Court of Auditors since 2014, and since September 2019 as Dean of his respective Chamber.

Ms. Petri Hofsté

Member of the Supervisory Board of Rabobank, Achmea, Fugro and Pon Holdings

Petri Hofsté is Member of the Supervisory Board of Rabobank, Achmea, Fugro and Pon Holdings. In addition, she is a Member of the Board of the Nyenrode Foundation. Ms. Hofsté holds a bachelor degree from Nyenrode University in Business Administration and Management and a Master's degree from the Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam in accounting and finance. Petri Hofsté has been listed as most influential business woman in the Netherlands for three years in a row.

Prof. Dante Pesce

Member of the UN Working Group on Business and Human Rights

Dante Pesce is member of the UN Working Group on Business and Human Rights. Prof. Pesce is the founder and Executive Director of the vincular Centre for Social Responsibility and Sustainable Development at the Catholic University of Valparaíso, Chile. He has actively collaborated in the development of international standards, such as ISO26000 and the OECD Guidelines for Multinational Corporations.

Dr. Pierrick Le Goff

Partner at De Gaulle Fleurance & Associés

Pierrick Le Goff has been General Counsel of Alstom since 2015 and is a member of its Executive Committee. He leads a team of 330 professionals worldwide, covering the areas of Legal, Ethics & Compliance, Contract Management and Intellectual Property. Mr. Le Goff is an affiliate Professor at the Sciences Po Law School in Paris. His teaching and speaker activities focus mainly on international business law, international litigation and arbitration, international construction law, corporate social responsibility as well as ethics and compliance.

Dr. Tererai Trent

Scholar, humanitarian, author, founder of Tererai Trent International

Ms. Trent is a Zimbabwean-born academic who taught herself to read from her brother's schoolbooks. At a young age, she left her home country for the United States in pursuit of her dream to obtain a bachelor's degree, a master's, and eventually a PhD degree. Her life story was featured in the 2009 book 'Half the Sky' by Nicholas Kristof and Sheryl WuDunn. In 2009, she founded the Tinogona Foundation, later renamed Tererai Trent International. Recently, a life-size statue of her was unveiled in New York City.

Mr. Loek Penders has been Chief Compliance & Privacy Officer at AkzoNobel since 2015. Mr. Penders and his team are responsible for creating and maintaining a suitable integrity culture and compliance framework in the company.
